

**UA Early College - Anticipated Costs for In-State Students

through August 2011**

In-state students who apply to UA Early College and submit an official high school transcript with a 3.0+ high school GPA receive a UA Early College partial tuition scholarship. Email earlycollege@ua.edu or call 1-877-823-8759 (205) 348-7083 if you have questions.

Application - Students pay a \$40.00 non-refundable application fee to UA Early College

After being accepted to UA Early College, students enroll in UAEC 200: Gateway Course. Students earn two hours of college credit when they complete/pass UAEC 200.
